

Ambassadors' Guide | 32nd SCHMS - 20th Forum with International Participation

A. Your Role

As an ambassador, your main responsibility is rather straightforward: **spread the word** and help others feel as excited for the Forum as we are! For that to happen, you'll need to do as many of the following as possible:

- Spread the word about the Forum within your network, university and on social media.
- Share important updates, announcements and deadlines with your peers.
- Highlight the benefits of attending, including - but not limited to - interactive lectures, medical workshops, live-streamed surgeries and the 30th Olympiad of Medical Knowledge.
- Promote opportunities of participants to showcase their research and actively participate in the conference with oral or poster presentations.
- Emphasize that for the first time international medical students have the chance to join round tables with professors from all over Europe.

B. First Steps

- Fill out the Ambassadors' application form.
- Follow the forum's social media accounts to stay updated.
- Complete your registration for the 32nd SCHMS and the 20th Forum with International Participation.
- If you're connected with international student groups or conferences, please inform the General Ambassador and add

details in the brainstorming folder, where you can also contribute ideas for the forum's promotion.

- Join the Discord Server of the Organising Team of the 32nd SCHMS and the 20th Forum with International Participation!

C. Coordinators

- Each Ambassador is assigned a coordinator who will support you throughout the year.
- Feel free to reach out to your coordinator for any questions or assistance with tasks.
- Your coordinator will check in with you to ensure everything is running smoothly.

Your primary goal is to bring **at least 3 participants** to the conference, using your unique referral code (which the participants you attract to the Forum will use during their Registration). If an ambassador brings a certain number of participants to the conference using their personal referral code, they will enjoy the following benefits:

- ≥ 10 participants ➡ 100% discount on registration fee
