

## GENERAL INFORMATION

E-posters offer flexibility and ease of design, as they can be created using Microsoft PowerPoint (or similar applications). Presentations will be displayed on large monitors rather than projectors, therefore preparation differs from a standard conference-room presentation. Please optimize your layout for screen viewing and avoid both overcrowded and overly minimal designs.

## PREPARATION – DESIGN

The e-poster must be submitted in **.jpg format**.

You may use one of the official congress PowerPoint templates (study or case report), but you must export the final file as **.jpg** and verify its proper display on a different computer.

E-posters are displayed on Full HD monitors (1920×1080 pixels) with a **16:9 aspect ratio**. Image files must therefore follow a **16:9 ratio** and have a resolution from **1280×720 up to 1920×1080 pixels** at **100–150 dpi**.

Use standard system fonts such as Arial, Tahoma, or Verdana.

## REQUIRED SETTINGS

### FONTS

Slide title:

Recommended size ≥ 25 pt

Authors & affiliations:

Recommended size ≥ 9 pt

Main text:

Recommended size ≥ 6 pt

Text in tables or figures:

Recommended size ≥ 6 pt

Comments and references:

Recommended size 4–6 pt

## STRUCTURE AND CONTENT

The presentation must consist of one page (jpg format), preferably using the official ppt/pptx template (study or case report).

## FIGURES AND TABLES (optional)

If you do not include figures or tables, you may remove the corresponding placeholders and redistribute the available space using larger fonts and expanded text areas.

## TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

Your e-Poster must meet the following requirements:

- JPG file with minimum resolution 1280×720 px at 150 dpi
- The e-poster may be created in PowerPoint and exported as an image
- To ensure correct dimensions in PowerPoint:  
Design → Slide Size → Wide Screen (16:9)
- To save the image:  
File → Save As → select .jpg
- E-posters must use **horizontal orientation**

## E-POSTER SUBMISSION

E-posters should be submitted via the form located on the Congress website.
